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## **EJCCA WCP Management Booklet**

The EJCCA **instructs** all club chairman, secretaries, coaches, managers, coordinators players and parents to acquaint themselves with the conditions and requirements under which the Ekurhuleni provincial winter cricket programme is run. A lack of knowledge of these requirements will **not** absolve any person or club of any liability, responsibility or consequence. This includes any information relating to the who, when, where, time, commitment and cost. *If in doubt call and ask!*

### **EJCCA Cricket By-laws.**

The cricket by-laws will be issued in a separate booklet. Teams will be allowed as per by-laws to play either 12 or 13 players. Our aim is to ensure all players have as much game time as possible.

### **Programme Requirements**

1. Team Managers are responsible for all team activities, arrangements and ensuring that the appropriate communication is conducted. Please refer to management roles and responsibilities.
2. The EJCCA will provide the basic cricket clothing requirements. All teams and players must comply with the dress code at all times.
3. The EJCCA teams must dress in a uniform manner as listed below. The EJCCA shall be the benchmark

#### **All players are to practise in the clothing provided.**

- Clean EJCCA practise shirt.
- Clean EJCCA practice shorts.
- Clean white socks.
- Wicket keepers may wear longs.

#### **All players are to travel in the following**

- Clean EJCCA practise cricket shirt.
- Clean EJCCA tracksuit, (Full).
- Clean EJCCA cricket cap.
- Clean track shoes.

#### **All players are required to play in the following:**

- Clean cream cricket longs.
- Clean EJCCA cricket shirt.
- Clean EJCCA cricket cap.
- Clean EJCCA cricket jersey.
- Proper cricket shoes / spikes.
- Own cricket kit, batting helmet and practise cricket ball.
- All batsman will wear a batting helmet as per by-laws.
- Players who have cricket spikes should also carry cricket shoes with rubber base as not all venues allow the wearing of cricket spikes.



4. No soccer or rugby balls allowed at any match. All players are required to watch the match and learn from the experience.



## **ECU & EJCCA DISCIPLINARY CODE**

### **Code of Conduct**

1. Particular reference is made to the Preamble of the Laws of Cricket 2000 Code.
2. Persons must not assault, attempt to assault or threaten to assault a spectator, another player or umpire.
3. Players must not abuse or dispute, as distinct from question, an umpire's decision, or act in an obviously provocative or disapproving manner either towards an umpire, his decision or generally following an umpiring decision.
4. Players must only wear and use approved clothing and equipment. The wearing or display of unauthorized commercial logo is not permitted.
5. Players must not use crude/abusive language. An umpire would be expected to caution the player and advise the captain of his concern before reporting any player for this type of behaviour.
6. Player must not indulge in conduct detrimental to the game.
7. Players must in no way use crude or abusive hand signals.
8. Persons must at all times abide by the playing conditions, rules and regulations, playing regulations and of the Eastern Cricket Union and Eastern Junior Club Cricket Association.
9. Persons must not engage in public acts of misconduct, or unruly public behaviour, whilst representing the Eastern Cricket Union or the Eastern Junior Club Cricket Association.
10. Any person by way of his actions or statements brings the game of cricket or the Eastern Cricket Union into disrepute shall be guilty of misconduct.
11. No provincial player may dispose of his playing clothing in any way.
12. No person may wear Eastern Cricket Union or provincial clothing should he not be entitled to do so.
13. A provincial player may only wear his provincial headgear whilst batting in senior club matches.
14. No player may wear the provincial clothing of another Union whilst playing in a match played under the auspices of the Eastern Cricket Union.
15. No Provincial player may wear their provincial clothing, except headgear (See 13), whilst batting or fielding in club matches. This shall apply to matches played at senior level only.
16. No player will be allowed to smoke, drink alcohol or use drugs, both on and off the field.
17. Unsupervised visits to places of entertainment will not be allowed when on tour.
18. No player is allowed to leave the practise or field location unless authorised by the team manager, and this must done under parental guidance.
19. No girls will be allowed into the rooms where players are accommodated when on tour.
20. There will be "lights out" policy when on cricket tours.
21. Littering is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
22. There will be no abuse of kit, clothing, playing facilities or any accommodation.



## General Requirements

1. Team management should ensure a “*positive vibe*” is created within the team and its activities, we request that parents support the team in this quest as negativity by any coach, manager, coordinator, player or parent will not be tolerated.
2. Coaches and managers must clearly communicate player role and responsibilities within each team. Players must play for the team within these roles and not their own agenda. Please allow each player to perform their role within the team and learn from the experience. No shouting at any player from the side lines will be tolerated and we mean “NO Shouting from any one”. The players do not need this added pressure.
3. Team management must be consistent and fair with team selections, with the aim of developing a correctly structured team, giving all players the opportunity to perform against their selected role in the team. Where a player is requiring specialised coaching they should be referred to the ECU head coach or to a local cricket coaching academy for further assistance.
4. The team will be professional in the way they play the game and all players must behave in an orderly manner on and off the field of play, each player supporting their co – players in all circumstances. Players are expected to play competitively on the field, but within the bounds of human dignity.
5. EJCCA parental and spectator support is sincerely appreciated and they should consider themselves to be representatives of Eastern Cricket Union and the Eastern Junior Club Cricket Association when supporting any fixture or practise involving their son and his team and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner as they are subject to the control and regulations set by the ECU and EJCCA from time to time.
6. Applauding of good cricket is encouraged; however applauding of poor cricket by any EJCCA representative will not be tolerated, nor at the expense of human dignity of the opposing team or its supporters.
7. Parents, supporters and spectators are requested to position themselves well clear of the boundary lines and may not walk onto the field before or during any match and must refrain from standing or sitting behind wickets at either end. Ie in front of the side screens.
8. Parents, supporters and spectators must ensure controlled consumption of any alcoholic beverage and ensure appropriate behaviour by all adults. Should any person become unruly at any match, it must be reported to the EJCCA executive who may call for the ban of such offender to any future matches. Let’s have fun, support our teams proudly and ensure there is no bitter taste left after any practise or match. We all want to see our players do well.
9. Team officials may not partake of any alcoholic beverage during any given practise session or during any match. This should be reserved for post match socials in a controlled manner.
10. Should there be continued player absenteeism the EJCCA reserves the right to request official school documentation for any school commitment.
11. All player indemnity forms must be completed in full “*prior*” to any cricket match or cricket tour. (*No Form “NO” Play*).



12. The onus is on the player and parent to inform the team manager of any medication that the player is taking and ensure that it is kept with the player at all times.
13. Should any parent have a concern this should be directed to the Team Manager in a positive manner. Major concerns should be placed in writing and directed to the EJCCA Executive.
14. Failure to comply with the above requirement may result in a player forfeiting to right to play any associated cricket match (*Home or away*) and may be subject to a disciplinary which could lead to the withdrawal of Ekurhuleni representative colours by the Eastern Cricket Union.

### **General Match and Practise Day Requirements.**

1. Comply with the respective cricket by-laws.
2. Team management shall ensure they know when and where their team is playing, this includes obtaining directions to the various venues. Team management must ensure players and parents are aware of venue location, it is preferable to travel together.
3. The ECU Willowmoore cricket grounds will be EJCCA home grounds and will be regarded as the official meeting point for all team members, especially the collection and drop off point for all development players and coaches. This is for both practise sessions, matches home and away, unless otherwise agreed and approved by the EJCCA executive.
4. All players are required to meet well in advance of the managements agreed time. **Team management shall not wait longer than 20 minutes from the agreed time, as we need to meet our match commitments on time.** Please request a concession if you are unable to meet this requirement. This request should be made timorously. *When in doubt call and ask!*
5. Match fees home and away are R35.00 per player per match and are payable prior to the match to the team manager.
6. Players are required to bring an additional energy drink. Parents are requested to assist the team manager with the catering requirements. Team management may sell food to spectators to raise additional funds.
7. All players are to welcome the opposition. Once the captains have tossed for the game all EJCCA players will gather together with the team coaches, awaiting the outcome of the toss. Captains must refrain from shouting out the result from the middle.
8. EJCCA fielders shall take the field in an orderly manner and clap the opposition's batsman on and off the field. At the fall of a wicket all EJCCA players may gather together to celebrate in a positive manner.
9. All team players, team management will be required to ensure any special instruction issued by the EJCCA from time to time is complied with.
10. Team managers must ensure match reports and statistics are submitted within seven days of any match and overall team results, statistics and reports as required by the EJCCA are submitted at the end of the season.



## **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF TEAM OFFICIALS.**

### **MANAGER**

- Responsible for the total management control of the team.
- Responsible for coordinating transport arrangements for players for both practise sessions and matches.
- Responsible for all team activities and general player discipline on and of the field at all times.
- Responsible for ensuring a high standard of dress code at all times.
- Responsible for team management communication and notification of all matches and practice dates.
- Responsible for reporting of any problems with players, parents or playing facilities etc.
- Responsible to ensure the game is played in accordance with the EJCCA bye-laws and any changes are agreed to prior to the match.
- Ensure team records are captured and reported as required by the EJCCA executive.
- Schedule and co-ordinate the team practice sessions and advise match fixture dates and requirements.
- Coordinate team selections with the team Coach, ensuring that a player does not sit out more than two consecutive matches, unless due to unavailability, injury or non attendance to practise sessions.
- Assist during practice sessions as directed by the Coach, ensuring players receive proper coaching.
- Control scoring / scorers and arrange umpires, if required assist with umpiring duties.
- Control, collect and receipt all monies e.g. subs, player fees.
- Additional non-fixture games to be approved by the EJCCA Provincial Co-ordinator or Chairman.
- Obtain permission for any press publication related to the team or Association.
- Discipline of a serious nature shall be controlled and administered by the EJCCA Executive as per the EJCCA disciplinary code and should be reported within (Seven) 7 days of the incident
- Attend all EJCCA meetings as required.
- Ensuring any instruction or arrangement is complied with as allocated by the EJCCA from time to time.

### **COACH**

- Responsible to ensure each player receives proper and sufficient practice and coaching.
- Responsible to nominate the batting and bowling line up from the team selections.
- Responsible to ensure each player is utilised in the role he was selected for.
- Responsible for player behaviour on the field of play, ensuring the game is played in the correct spirit, eliminating excessive talking, abusive language and player misconduct.
- Responsible to ensure the game is played in accordance with the EJCCA bye-laws and any changes are agreed to prior to the match.
- Responsible to Umpire the match.
- Attend all EJCCA meetings as required.
- Assist with coordinating notification & transport of development players to all practise & match sessions.
- Coach and Manager to agree on all decision making and assist one another where necessary.

### **TEAM COORDINATOR**

- Assist the team manager where required.
- Responsible for team administration, practice attendance register, match register, match stats and compiling of reports and general team record keeping.
- Responsible to arrange and co-ordinate all lunches drinks etc on and off the field.
- Responsible to liaise with parents on all activities and up coming games.
- Assist manager in organizing transport where necessary for players.
- Responsible for ensuring that all facilities are left clean and tidy after games.
- Control and maintain team kit bag, stumps and first aid bag.
- Injury control, ensuring all indemnity forms & medical details are completed and available at all times.
- Attend all EJCCA meetings as required.
